Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported on attendance at the annual Kansas Rural Water Conference, that the roof repairs at the water pump house were completed except for the sky light and that he was waiting on asphalt repair bids.

Superintendent Zlatnik inquired about opening gate at forestry burn pile. Following discussion council requested that gate remain locked with residents contacting City Hall to get code when needing to use the facility.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported on meeting with Matt Stormer of KDOT regarding updates to crosswalks on Highway 24.

Chief Sipp also reported on new camera system that has been installed at police station, security measures for court session, vehicle repairs, drone bill and installation of new bracket for license plate readers.

Council had discussion regarding structure at 416 Navarre that has been damaged by fire. Following discussion motion by Dan Glotzbach to declare the structure at 416 Navarre an immediate hazard as per 4-512 of the Rossville City Code and order the property vacated and secured was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried.

Mayor James Meyer appointed Randy Dick to the Rossville Planning Commission. Motion by Trish Heim to approve appointment was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Mayor James Meyer appointed Robin Seele to the Rossville Planning Commission. Motion by Todd Reeves to approve appointment was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Trish Heim and carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:42 pm.
