The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, December 18, 2023 at 6:00pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Vern Sumner, Dan Glotzbach, and Rick Towers. Todd Reeves was absent.

Also present were Alan Zlatnik, Lisa Stum, Thomas Sipp, and Randi Reaney.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve minutes of the December 4, 2023 meeting as written was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$41,083.67 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve agenda with the addition of Randi Reaney was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Randi Reaney addressed the council about her Pit Bull that was formerly located at her residence. Randi Reaney stated that her Pit Bull is a service dog for her daughter and an ESA dog for herself. Randi Reaney questioned whether under these circumstances the Pit Bull can return to her residence. Mayor stated City Attorney needed to review the matter. No action was taken.

Darryl Olson arrived at 6:08pm.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to add Darryl Olson to the agenda was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Darryl Olson expressed concerns about migrant buses and questioned whether or not Rossville had policies regarding the issue. Council thanked Darryl Olson for bringing the matter to their attention. No further action was taken.

Application for cereal malt beverage license from Wehner's of Rossville for sale in original and unopened containers was presented. Application for cereal malt beverage from Rossville American Legion Post #31 for consumption on premises was presented. Assistant Clerk noted that background checks had been completed and fees paid. Potential of raising CMB license fee was addressed as the cost of the background checks had surpassed the rate of the CMB license fee. No action was taken.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve CMB license for Rossville American Legion Post #31 was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve CMB license for Wehner's of Rossville was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Application to operate a Class "A" Club was presented by Rossville American Legion Post #31. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve Class "A" Club license was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Application for drinking establishment license from Dawg House was presented. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve license was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Application for liquor store license from Shanna Perine DBA Rossville Liquor was presented. Motion by Trish Heim to approve license was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Mayor stated he had attended ribbon cutting for first phase of walking trail on Wednesday, December 13, 2023.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported about a visit from the Kansas Department of Health and Environment on Tuesday, December 12, 2023. Superintendent Zlatnik reported that the KDHE had found no major discrepancies.

Superintendent Zlatnik and council discussed purchase of new excavator. Mayor reported 2023 model was unavailable for purchase. Mayor presented quote from White Star Machinery for 2024 model. Motion by Rick Towers to approve the purchase of the 2024 excavator for \$66,984.56 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp presented report of police activities and incident report as of November 30, 2023.

Chief Sipp reported on ongoing repairs at police station.

Chief Sipp noted the cost of CMB license background checks in comparison to the cost of the CMB license fee.

Chief Sipp addressed the replacement of the 2013 Tahoe beginning in 2024.

Council set end of year meeting for Thursday, December 28, 2023 at 9:00am.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:12pm.
