

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, December 21, 2020 at 6:59 pm by Mayor Kenneth Wichman using online Zoom meeting.

Motion by James Meyer to approve minutes of the December 7, 2020 meeting as written was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$34,707.08 was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Alan Zlatnik logged in at 7:02pm.

Motion by Christi McKenzie to approve agenda as written was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Clerk presented applications for cereal malt beverage licenses noting that as applications were not submitted 10 days in advance of meeting background check had not been completed but all fees had been paid.

Motion by James Meyer to approve cereal malt beverage license for the American Legion for consumption on premises provided that background check shows the applicant is qualified was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Motion by Christi McKenzie to approve private club license for American Legion was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Christi McKenzie to approve cereal malt beverage license for Prairie Gypsy for consumption on premises provided that background check shows the applicant is qualified was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Mayor reported that he had talked to Titus Bond of Beyond Baseball and they will be submitting schedule soon along with list of improvements that they are wanting to the ball facility at Campbell field. Clerk reported that \$2,000.00 deposit required by the contract had been submitted.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that the utility department only had 6 more regular size meters to install and some larger meters to install to complete the meter replacement project.

Superintendent Alan Zlatnik requested permission to purchase mower to replace 15-year-old mower at cost of \$10,000.00. Following discussion motion by Toby McCullough to approve purchase of mower was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Toby McCullough noted that there were still some couches, chairs and unsightly items setting out in yards of some properties.

Jason Connell logged in at 7:18pm.

Council discussed clean up at certain properties, fence completion at 615 Maple Court and changes in police shifts to address recent increase in break-ins with Police Chief Jason Connell.

Clerk presented request from Rossville High School for donation to Project Prom. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve donation of \$250.00 was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Council scheduled end of year meeting for Wednesday, December 30, 2020 at 9:00 am.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Trish Heim and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:33pm.
