Motion by Trish Heim to pay bills as presented totaling \$47,857.53 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve agenda as written was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Council President James Meyer reported on meeting that Mayor, Drainage Board and Shawnee County had regarding repairs to the drainage ditch at north edge of Rossville.

Utility Employee Brad Kirk reported that Evergy had advised that if the poles in the City Park are replaced the City installed outlet/fixtures would not be reinstalled. Following discussion motion by Toby McCullough to have Perry Electric repair any safety issues on poles at City Park and get quote to relocate services from Evergy poles was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Christi McKenzie arrived at 7:07pm.

Brad Kirk reported that the City Utility department had received request from property owner at 239 Main Street to install new culvert. Following discussion council instructed Kirk to contact Shawnee County regarding culvert as Main Street is maintained by the county.

Police Chief Jason Connell had nothing to report to council.

Council inquired about swimming pools being put up without required fencing. Chief Connell to check and notify residents.

Christi McKenzie asked Chief Connell about any plans for bike rodeo this year. Chief Connell said no plans were made to hold such event this year.

Council discussed video service agreement with WTC. Following discussion council tabled matter in order to get information on service provided to fire dept., library, city hall and police station.

Council had discussion regarding Rossville Foundation plans for walking trail.

Council reviewed email from Rossville Community Development Committee regarding corn eating contest for Tall Corn Festival. Following discussion motion by Trish Heim to provide corn for this event was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Thank you letter from the City of Willard for assistance during wild fire was presented.

Christi McKenzie inquired about spraying for mosquitos. Brad Kirk reported that the utility department would be starting soon.

James Meyer inquired about fluoride being added to water. Clerk reported that past councils in the past have voted to not add fluoride. This was based on concerns that fluoride can be toxic at certain levels and would require equipment to monitor and regulate the levels in the water.

Council had discussion regarding mowing of right of way at far east end of East Perry Street. Brad Kirk noted that adjacent property owner had asked that City not mow and that he would maintain.

Christi McKenzie inquired about big trucks running over curb at Rossville Liquor Store. No action was taken.

Motion by Trish Heim to adjourn was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:35pm.
