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City Hall November 16, 2020

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, November 16, 2020 at 7:02 pm by Council President James Meyer using online Zoom meeting.

Other council members present via Zoom were Trish Heim, Dan Glotzbach, Christi McKenzie and Toby McCullough.

Motion by Toby McCullough to approve minutes of the November 2, 2020 meeting as written was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to pay bills as presented totaling \$103,653.06 was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve agenda as written was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Christi McKenzie inquired about any changes to the Christmas Festival plans due to new COVID-19 mandates. Jason Connell and Mindy Fiedler reported on plans for festival.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that Bettis Asphalt have completed the street overlay projects.

Superintendent Zlatnik requested permission to purchase new snow blade at cost of \$1,500.00. Motion by Toby McCullough to allow purchase of snow blade was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Superintendent Zlatnik reported that his department had about 45 new radio read meters left to install. Most of the remaining meters require the old meters to be dug up to install new meters.

Police Chief Jason Connell reported that his department was investigating burglaries at the storage units in Rossville.

Chief Connell reported that invoice presented tonight from Free State Alarm Company, LLC in the amount of \$1305.50 was for the purchase of new security camera's and requested permission to pay for camera's using funds from the Special Law Enforcement Trust "assets forfeiture" account. Motion by Trish Heim to allow use of funds was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Chief Connell reported on recent vehicle maintenance issues.

Trish Heim inquired about recent purchase of badges from Galls, Inc. Chief Connell noted that badges were for the 150 anniversary. Council had further discussion with Chief Connell about report on social media regarding kids vandalizing property and coyote carcasses found at swimming pool. No action was taken.

Council had discussion regarding city holiday dinner and new COVID-19 mandates and decided to put dinner celebration plans on hold until COVID -19 issues are resolved.

Code Enforcement Administrator Jeffrey Overmyer reported on the 54-page report provided to the City from FEMA Silverjackets and noted that the City did not have to pursue any of the options presented in report but representative would be willing to attend meeting to further discuss the proposals at the request of the City council.

Overmyer reported that following meeting on November 4th with Steve Samuelson work continued to bring properties in Rossville in compliance to qualify for the CRS program. As of now only nine properties remain open.

Clerk presented application from Casey's General Store for cereal malt beverage license for sale in original and unopened container. Clerk reported that all fees have been paid and background check completed. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve license was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:48 pm.
