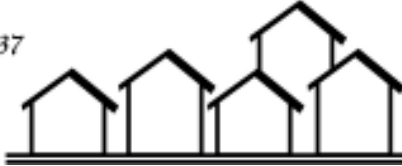

September 21, 2020

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, September 21, 2020 at 6:59 pm by Mayor Kenneth Wichman.

Council members present were Trish Heim, James Meyer, Christi McKenzie and Dan Glotzbach.

Also present were Alan Zlatnik and Jason Connell.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve minutes of the September 8, 2020 meeting as written was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to pay bills as presented totaling \$38,585.28 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by James Meyer to approve agenda as written was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Toby McCullough was sworn in as new councilmember.

Mayor reported that meeting with David DeVore of BG Consultants to discuss design of bathrooms/storm shelter for park was to be held tomorrow at 2pm in City Hall.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that the playground mulch had been installed and they were continuing to work on repairs to the playground equipment. Zlatnik sent shout out to councilmember James Meyer for redesigning and building replacement to silo roof of play equipment.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that approximately 380 new meters have been installed leaving about 90 left to do.

Christi McKenzie reported that the Rossville High School and Jr High will ensure that the students are not allowed to use playground equipment designed for younger aged children during school hours.

Police Chief Jason Connell reported on need to update camera and video equipment in several areas of the City. Chief Connell to get quotes for upgrades.

Chief Connell reported that the Rossville Police Department assisted the Kansas Highway Patrol with high speed car chase that went through Rossville and that the vehicle was successfully stopped.

Chief Connell reported that part time officer off for work comp related injury is back to work.

Council discussed the annual Halloween hot dog/Chili feed with Chief Connell. Chief Connell noted that activity would need to be cancelled due to COVID-19 restrictions and public safety concerns.

Clerk requested permission for Asst. Clerk to attend 3rd year of Clerk Institute. Institute will be online this year so travel and motel would not be needed. Cost of Institute would be \$385.00. Motion by James Meyer to allow Asst. Clerk to attend was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Mayor reported that Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas had returned one month of dental premiums to the City as employees were not able to access dental offices due to COVID shut downs. Mayor noted that the premiums paid by employees for dental insurance would not be withheld from employees pay for the month of October in order to return this refund to employees.

James Meyer reported concerns about bridge south of Rossville over Cross Creek falling into creek thereby restricting water flow. Following discussion Mayor noted that he would contact Shawnee County Commissioners regarding matter.

Trish Heim reported that she would be attending Solid Waste Committee Meeting on Monday, September 28th.

Council discussed sidewalk and code violations at Thederahn property. Mayor to check with Code Enforcement Officer Jeffrey Overmyer about progress.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:29pm.
