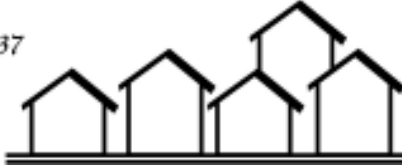

April 20, 2026

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, April 20, 2026 at 5:59 pm by Council President Trish Heim.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Rick Towers, Vern Sumner, Dan Glotzbach and Todd Reeves.

Also present were Chance Stum, Thomas Sipp, Myron Leinwetter, Seth Brackman, Jenna Stum, Adrianna Brown, Josie Harden, Alexis Hamilton, Kayla Hurla, Kayla Harden and Tracy Paige.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve the minutes of the April 6, 2026 meeting as presented was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$97,704.37 was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve the agenda deleting Stephanie Giachino and Dan Holloway and adding Tracy Paige and Jenna Stum was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Kayla Harden noted that she does not live in the city limits of Rossville but, at the request of a friend, she put a survey on Facebook regarding the City of Rossville pit bull dog ban. Harden noted that 78% of the responses to the survey were in favor of having the ban removed. Harden also reported on other cities that had removed similar bans and cited online articles/studies regarding pit bull dogs.

Tracy Paige reported that she is part of a rescue, foster dog program and that bans on a specific breed of dog prohibits good dogs from being adopted and requested that the City consider changing ordinance.

Following presentation by Kayla Harden and Tracy Paige motion by Todd Reeves to repeal pit bull dog ban in the City of Rossville died for lack of a second.

Jenna Stum representing the Rossville Community Recreation Association was present to request the transfer of the \$2,000.00 budgeted for RCRA and to request that the City consider funding the purchase of first aid kits for each summer ball team at a cost of \$15.00 each. Following discussion motion by Dan Glotzbach to transfer \$2,000.00 budgeted for RCRA and to purchase 12 first aid kits for use by RCRA was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried.

Clerk presented first quarter 2026 financial report for council review.

Utility Superintendent Chance Stum presented quote from Approved Asphalt to resurface Orange Street from Anderson to Perry at a cost of \$56,000.00. Stum also reported on four areas in streets that need dug up and repaired at estimated cost of \$7,000.00. Following discussion council approved proceeding with repairs to four areas as identified and took no action on resurfacing of Orange Street. Repairs to start after school goes on summer break to reduce traffic issues.

Superintendent Stum presented quote from Schulte Supply to purchase line locator at cost of \$5,294.34. Following discussion regarding cost of calibration of unit matter was tabled.

Superintendent Stum reported that he was working with Kansas Rural Water Association; on lead and copper testing/reports and survey's; sewer lagoon splitter box replacement; rock needed to stop erosion at sewer lagoon ponds and scheduling time for KRWA to come to town and exercise and service water valves.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to go into executive session for 15 minutes to discuss legal issue with City Attorney was seconded by Rick Towers and carried. Executive session to be from 6:59 pm to 7:14 pm with Council, Attorney, Utility Superintendent, City Clerk and Police Chief to attend.

Council reconvened in open session at 7:10 pm.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported that; he and Brooklyn attend KBI disposition conference on April 8th; he attended book buddies at RGS on April 10th; he ordered new sign for police station and will get put up soon; Captain Hammer worked after prom and said everything was quiet; he and Brooklyn will be attending Kansas Criminal Justice Information Systems conference in Wichita; the battery went dead on 2013 Tahoe and that Captain Hammer removed flashlight from vehicle to fix issue and that he would be attending Kansas Chief's of Police Conference in Mulvane on May 4th.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp presented incident report for March.

Clerk presented information from Blue Cross Blue Shield of Kansas, Freedom Claims and Theel Insurance on renewal of health insurance coverage. Following discussion motion by Vernon Sumner to renew as recommended by Theel Insurance was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Council discussed no parking zone on Highway 24 Trafficway in front of Casey's General Store. No action was taken

Council was advised that the Jackson County Planning Commission proposal for solar farm moratorium failed on a 4 to 4 vote.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Rick Towers and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:23 p.m.
