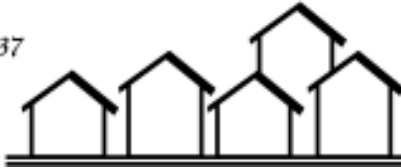

April 7, 2025

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, April 7, 2025 at 5:59 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Vern Sumner, Dan Glotzbach and Rick Towers. Todd Reeves was absent.

Also present were Thomas Sipp and Alan Zlatnik.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve the minutes of the March 17, 2025 meeting as presented was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$66,228.17 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve the agenda as presented was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Mayor James Meyer reported that he had met with an individual doing commercial tree service work regarding his request to access the City forestry dump. Mayor noted that he had invited individual to come to council meeting to discuss the position of the City Council to prohibit commercial dumping in the forestry dump. Following discussion no action was taken.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik noted that it was time to look at streets. Zlatnik to get with Vern Sumner and review streets.

Superintendent Zlatnik reported that he was getting bids for playground mulch and had talked to Christi McKenzie regarding assistance with funding.

City discussed railroad crossing repairs and noted that new asphalt walking area was made along Anderson Street Crossing.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported that; he will be attending the Kansas Chief's of Police conference next week; vehicles have been equipped with the new Axon in-car cameras but radar units will need to be upgraded; electrical work at station has been completed however the A/C unit was not working so new capacitor was put in by Richards Appliance, Heating and Cooling; he is working with Jayme Green of Topeka Police Department to schedule bike rodeo; Mid-South Radar will be out to re-certify the radar units; number of dogs living at 126 Navarre has been reduced to 3 and they have been registered; KSCPOST roster verification was made; he spent several mornings and afternoons directing traffic on Highway 24 and Main while railroad crossings were closed and that he will continue to monitor to make sure traffic is moving smoothly. In addition, Chief Sipp noted that he had talked to railroad person in charge regarding the third set of tracks.

Council inquired about number of hours part time police personnel are working. Following discussion no action was taken.

Council discussed quotes for employee health insurance. Following discussion council decided to proceed with getting quote from Theel Insurance.

Clerk reviewed items noted during legal review of the Rossville City Code book as part of the recodification process by Civic Plus.

Clerk presented request for water bill adjustment from owner of property at 405 Navarre due to water leak at residence. Following discussion motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve adjustment by half the overage was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried.

Council inquired about swimming pool being ready for upcoming season. Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik to check with Shawnee County Parks and Recreation on progress of repairs.

Council discussed possible code violations on property on Walnut Street. Chief Sipp to check property.

Mayor reported on meeting with Rossville Community Development Committee regarding plans for Tall Corn Festival. No action was taken.

Council discussed City regulations on chickens within the City limits and reviewed ordinance #819. No action was taken.

Motion by Vern Sumner to adjourn was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Meeting adjourned at 8:18pm.
