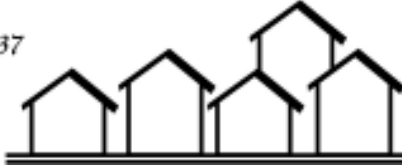

August 18, 2025

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, August 18, 2025 at 5:58 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Todd Reeves, Dan Glotzbach, Rick Towers and Vern Sumner.

Also present were Chance Stum and Douglas Schreiner.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve the minutes of the August 4, 2025 meeting as written was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$44,735.71 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adopt agenda as written was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Utility Employee Chance Stum reported that splitter box at sewer lagoons needs to be replaced as the current box is in bad shape. In addition, Stum noted that rip rap needs to be added to stop erosion at lagoons.

Council discussed street overlay project that is set to be done by Approved Paving LLC.

Assistant Police Chief Douglas Schreiner presented July incident numbers and noted that most of Highway 24 is now a construction zone due to work being done on the bridge.

Assistant Chief Schreiner reported that tall corn festival went well with no major incidents besides the single incident on Friday.

Assistant Chief Schreiner reported that resident at 324 Main Street had been issued citation for nuisances and weeds and that dog issues at 420 Orange had been settled.

Council discussed underage operation of ATV's and vehicles not stopping for pedestrians in crosswalks on Highway 24 despite new signals.

Motion by Rick Towers to go into executive session for 15 minutes to discuss personnel was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Executive session to be from 6:32pm to 6:47pm with Mayor and council attending.

Motion by Trish Heim to extend executive session for 5 minutes was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Council reconvened in open session at 6:57 pm.

Clerk reported that state statute 12-504 addresses vacation of streets and the City would need to obtain a legal description of the property to be vacated and hold hearing before a street can be vacated. Following discussion, a motion by Todd Reeves to move forward with proposal to close a section of Parkway Street east of the driveway at 204 Parkway to the school drive was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried with Todd Reeves, Dan Glotzbach and Vernon Sumner voting aye and Trish Heim and Rick Towers voting nay.

Clerk reminded council that next council meeting and budget hearing would be on Tuesday, September 2, 2025 due to the holiday on Monday.

Mayor appointed Chance Stum as Utility Superintendent at a salary of \$33.00 per hour. Motion by Todd Reeves to approve appointment and salary was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Mayor reported that he would review applications for utility employee position with Chance Stum and set up interviews for this week.

Mayor reported on plans for ball stadium repairs.

Council inquired about building permits for property at 425-429 Main Street. Clerk noted that property owner has been in contact with Jeffrey Overmyer regarding the property.

Mayor reported on decision to proceed with appeal on solar suit.

Council had discussion regarding some changes for next year in hours worked by City personnel for ball tournament and tall corn festival as well as possible changes to collection of fees for campers in park and governing body volunteering to assist RCDC.

Council noted that some holes at the old Short Stop building had been filled in.

Motion by Todd Reeves to adjourn was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:44pm.
