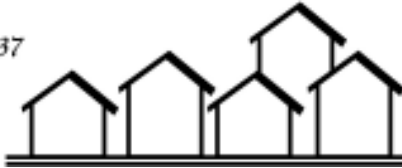

December 1, 2025

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, December 1, 2025 at 6:00 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Dan Glotzbach, Rick Towers and Vern Sumner. Todd Reeves was absent.

Also present were Thomas Sipp and Myron Leinwetter.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve the minutes of the November 17, 2025 meeting as presented was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$27,504.99 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve the agenda as presented was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Mayor reported that Casey's General Store is willing to agree to an easement across their property for the purpose of a walking trail if the City will maintain the property and put in a picnic table for use by Casey's and walking trail patrons.

Council reviewed email from Scott Guest offering to donate land currently being used as parking between the railroad and dentist office to the City. Following discussion council requested that the City Attorney work with Guest to proceed with land donation.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported on; complaints about drivers not stopping for school busses that have stopped sign deployed; vehicles parked along Perry Street at 503 Orange in grass; bid for replacement of police computers, server and background check for the owner of Bit by Bit Solutions. Chief Sipp also reported that he has a staff meeting scheduled for December 5th if the Mayor or council has anything needing to be addressed.

Following discussion with Chief Sipp and review of bid from Bit by Bit Solutions for replacement of computers and server motion by Rick Towers to approve purchase of four computers and equipment at a cost not to exceed \$9,561.28 was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Mayor reported that he had received message from resident expressing thanks for the good job in clearing the roads of snow after the recent storm.

Mayor presented request from Rossville Community Development Committee to have the 400 block of Main Street and East Perry Street closed in the evening on December 6th for Christmas parade and celebration. Council had discussion of possible parking issues due to planned activities at the American Legion. Following discussion council requested that Mayor contact RCDC and have them coordinate plans with American Legion.

Mayor presented request from Rossville High School cheer team for sponsorship to fund trip to nationals. Following discussion no action was taken.

Council had discussion on lumber from ball diamond grandstands that can be used to make projects and encouraged anyone wanting to make projects to donate any proceeds to the Rossville Foundation for continued support of the grandstand. Council also discussed signage to be put up at the grandstand and field.

Council asked Myron Leinwetter about trees in park that would need to be removed to allow for construction of walking trail. Leinwetter noted that trees would be looked at by arborist to determine the best action.

Motion by Trish Heim to adjourn was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:45pm.
