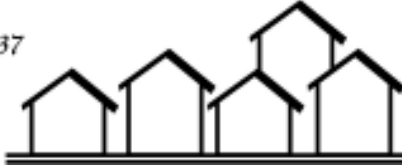

December 15, 2025

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, December 15, 2025 at 5:59 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Dan Glotzbach, Rick Towers, Vern Sumner, and Todd Reeves.

Also present were Thomas Sipp and Chance Stum.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve the minutes of the December 1, 2025 meeting as corrected was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$52,255.28 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve the agenda as presented was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

CMB license application for Rossville Market LLC for sale of cereal malt beverages in original and unopened containers was presented. Motion by Todd Reeves to approve license was seconded by Trish Heim and carried. CMB license application for Rossville Fresh Market for sale of cereal malt beverages in original and unopened containers was presented. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve license was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Application to operate a Class "A" Club was presented by the Rossville American Legion Post #31. Motion by Todd Reeves to approve Class "A" Club license was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried.

Mayor reminded council of end of year meeting scheduled for December 29<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm.

Mayor reported that he and Council Member Trish Heim met with Levi Henry in regards to the solar farms. Mayor told council that the meeting had gone well and that he is expecting to hear back from Levi in the next few weeks.

Utility Superintendent Chance Stum reported that the utility department had; put up Christmas lights, flushed fire hydrants, winterized sprinkler systems, received their lift, and trimmed trees in the park. Superintendent Stum told council that the utility department is attempting to filter old diesel fuel out of one of the generators. Superintendent Stum also advised council that the utility department is trying to repair some of the street lights on Main Street rather than buy brand new light heads. Mayor informed Superintendent Stum that he received more compliments on the removal of snow from the streets in early December.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported that; he has been monitoring school bus route on South Main Street, he issued a 10-day notice to abate to residents of 503 Orange, he held a staff meeting on December 5<sup>th</sup>, he and Captain Hammer assisted with traffic control at the Christmas Parade, he received background report from KBI on owner of Bit by Bit Solutions, he and Brooklyn had attended KCJIS NCIC and TAC training, and that the dentist office trimmed the low hanging branches over the sidewalk. Chief Sipp also reviewed the Police Data report year to date as of November 30, 2025.

Mayor reported that it will cost around \$600 to \$800 to obtain parking spaces between the railroad and dentist office.

Lisa Stum arrived at 6:51 pm.

After discussion motion by Rick Towers to proceed with obtaining the parking spaces between the railroad and dentist office was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Mayor presented request from Myron Leinwetter on behalf of the Rossville Community Foundation to put up historical trailside marker along the Rossville Community Trail. Motion by Vern Sumner to approve a historical trailside marker along the Rossville Community Trail was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Council discussed potential names for the field and grandstands, which would be placed on the historical trailside marker. After discussion council agreed to calling the field and grandstands "McPherson Family Grandstand at Joe Campbell Field."

Motion by Vern Sumner to adjourn was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:14 pm.
