

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, December 20, 2021 at 7:00 pm by Mayor Kenneth Wichman.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$33,870.51 was seconded by James Meyer and carried.

Motion by James Meyer to approve agenda as written was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried.

Clerk presented application from Rossville Liquor Store for liquor store license and reported that fee had been paid. Motion by Christi McKenzie to approve license for Liquor Store was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Clerk presented application from Fastdraws LLC for cereal malt beverage license for consumption on premises and reported that fees had been paid. Motion by Trish Heim to approve license was seconded by James Meyer and carried.

Mayor reported on the progress of the stone for the City welcome signs.

Mayor reported that he had no new information on repairs to the drainage ditch.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported on the damage to the lights and fence at Campbell stadium and street light on Main Street due to high winds. Zlatnik also reported that utility department had overtime during power outage as they were monitoring lift stations and water plant and had to pump lift stations using generator.

Police Chief Jason Connell reported that he was working on possible condemnation of trailer at 425 E Pottawatomie due to health and building code violations. Chief Connell also reported that pit bull puppies have been removed from City however he was notified that there is another pit bull in town and he will be working on this issue.

Chief Connell reported that WTC will be updating City properties on January 12, 2021.

Council inquired about police coverage for Christmas and New Years. Chief Connell reported that coverage was scheduled.

Council had discussion regarding emails from Myron Leinwetter regarding proposed walking trails. Following discussion council agreed to have City Attorney Stanley Oyler proceed with lease agreement.

Council scheduled end of year meeting for Wednesday, December 29, 2021 at 5:45pm at the Rossville American Legion.

Clerk reported that owner of property at 615 Maple Court had called City Hall to report that his fence was damage by high winds and that he would have repaired as soon as he could get contractor to complete the work. He noted that he had secured so that dogs would not be able to get out.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Christi McKenzie and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:30pm.
