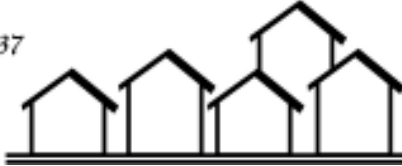

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$62,900.78 was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve agenda as written was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Clerk presented end of year finance report for council review.

Clerk presented report of Willard Court/Police services for 2021.

Mayor Meyer reported that he had talked to City Attorney Stanley Oyler regarding proposed Cross Creek trail and that he was still working with property owner on the liability insurance portion of the lease agreement. City Attorney to continue to work on draft of agreement.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik provided prices from J. Warren for options to lighting at Campbell Ball Stadium. Following discussion Zlatnik reported that he would be getting additional quotes.

Superintendent Zlatnik requested permission for Brad Kirk and himself to attend the Rural Water Conference in Wichita, March 29-31. Following discussion motion by Trish Heim to allow Zlatnik and Kirk to attend Rural Water Conference was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Police Chief Jason Connell reported that owner of pit bull dog had been advised to remove dog and inoperable vehicles from property.

Chief Connell reported that he was still working on arrangements for inspection of property at 425 E. Pottawatomie Street.

Council congratulated Chief Connell on recent award.

Council inquired about camera system quote.

Chief Connell reported that WTC had installed services for internet and phones at City Hall, Police Dept and City Shop building.

Clerk reported that Insurance carrier had advised the City that they will no longer be a market for public entity class of business and would not be renewing the City policy. Clerk noted that bids for insurance have been requested.

Council discussed possibly scheduling future work sessions. No action was taken.

Motion by Toby McCullough to adjourn was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:43pm.
