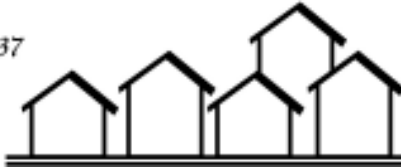

June 15, 2026

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, June 15, 2026 at 5:59 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Rick Towers, Vern Sumner, Todd Reeves and Dan Glotzbach.

Also present were Thomas Sipp, Myron Leinwetter, Darry Olson and Abby Perry.

Motion by Todd Reeves to approve the minutes of the June 1, 2026 meeting as presented was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Todd Reeves to pay bills as presented totaling \$54,558.56 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve the agenda with addition of Myron Leinwetter and Abby Perry was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried.

Darryl Olson was present to provide research he had completed and express concerns about the riding of e-scooters by minors without any safety equipment such as helmets. Council had discussion with Darryl Olson. No action was taken.

Abby Perry representing the Rossville Healthcare and Rehabilitation Center was present to request permission to discharge fireworks for celebration on Friday June 26, 2026. Motion by Rick Towers to allow discharge of fireworks on June 26<sup>th</sup> was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Myron Leinwetter was present to update council on grant applications. Council discussed grant for funding school crossing guards and bike safety. No action was taken.

Mayor reported that he was working on information regarding the parking area along West Anderson Street.

Mayor Meyer appointed Lisa Stum as member of the Board of Zoning Appeals for 1 year term. Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve appointment was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported on email from KDOT regarding sign requirements for engine braking signs. Following discussion council agreed to have Todd Reeves order signs/posts. Todd Reeves to install signs.

Chief Sipp reported that; he had ordered VIN inspection forms; Carlson Road was closed for two days after pole was blown over in storm and was resolved after numerous phone calls to Evergy; he issued 10-day notice to abate to 239 Main Street; he had a copy of the Silver Lake ordinance regarding scooters and provided copy to council.

Chief Sipp reported on program with U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement. Training would be at no cost to the department and could be useful tool. Following discussion motion by Todd Reeves to allow the Rossville Police Department to explore entering into a memorandum of agreement for the program 287(g) was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Chief Sipp presented May incident report.

Chief Sipp reported that police report was prepared for damage to memorial bench in front of City Hall after car drove onto sidewalk and into bench. Trying to determine if damage would exceed \$1,000.00.

Council discussed inoperable vehicles at car lot; estimated time frame for new code books and sink hole in drainage area between properties in Kross Subdivision. Clerk noted resident on Orange Street had contacted the office regarding pot holes and noted that this was in the area that the City had received quote from Approved Paving LLC for overlay project.

Clerk provided Council with preliminary budget and mil levy estimates to review for next meeting.

Council noted that they would be scheduling work on City Park after Tall Corn Festival activities.

Council had discussion regarding sign at park shelter house regarding reservations. Clerk to look at QR code sign.

Motion by Trish Heim to adjourn was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:37pm.
