Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$44,395.41 was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve the agenda with the addition of Myron Leinwetter was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Myron Leinwetter reported that the 5K Toadstrangler trail race would be May 17th and noted that he had received complaint about the condition of the park bathrooms. Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik noted that the park bathrooms have been closed for the winter and are not yet open.

Myron Leinwetter inquired about getting water fountain on the walking trail back on and noted that May 7th would be the bike to school event and that they were working on scheduling a bike rodeo.

Council also discussed repairs being made to the railroad crossings in town, possible waiver from railroad on concrete removal to allow for removal of grain bins and presentation on the ball diamond grandstands to the Shawnee County Historical Society.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported on water master meter malfunction and discussed burn pile and removal of Christmas decorations from Main Street.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported; that he and Brooklyn did presentation on crosswalk safety at the Rossville grade school; that the installation of cameras will be April 1st; that electrical work at the police station will be finished up today; that new license plate reader cameras have been installed; that he had attended the region 1 Kansas Association of Chief's of Police meeting; that he attended the Willard City Council meeting and police and court agreements have been signed by the Mayor; that he has signed as part of the Shawnee County Drug Enforcement Task Force and that Brooklyn would be attend court clerk training.

Chief Sipp presented February 2025 incident report and reported that he had been notified of a dog bite issue involving a resident with more than three dogs.

Mayor reported that there was no new information from the architect or engineer on the ball stadium repairs.

No new information has been received regarding employee health insurance renewal.

Motion by Trish Heim to adjourn was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:32pm.
