Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$38,003.92 was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Motion by Todd Reeves to approve the agenda as presented was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Darren Booth of Theel Insurance gave presentation to council on employee group health insurance using Freedom Claims Management, Inc.

Thomas Sipp arrived at 6:29pm.

Mayor reported that he was setting up meeting with architect and engineer to discuss baseball stadium restoration project.

Utility Employee Chance Stum advised council that it had determined that the master water meter is not reading correctly and they are getting prices to replace. Stum also reported Kansas Rural Water Association had offered to work with the City to develop a source water protection plan for the City. Plan would be completed by KRWA at no cost to the City. Following discussion motion by Todd Reeves to request assistance from KRWA in developing a source water protection plan was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported that; he would be going grade school on March 12th to provide crosswalk education; he still has not received a date from Axon on installation of vehicle camera system; Brooklyn and himself had submitted all of the past federal forfeiture forms and Rossville is now compliant; installation of the new electrical services and additional outlets at the police station will begin this week; new license plate reader cameras to be install March 10th at the expense of Shawnee County Sheriff's Department; he was approached about trying to organize a bike rodeo and he is still waiting on signed agreements from the City of Willard. Mayor reported that Christi McKenzie was working on a 20-minute presentation on the baseball stadium for the Shawnee County Historical Society.

Council requested that representative from Bukaty Companies be asked to attend meeting to discuss employee health insurance.

Motoin by Trish Heim to adjourn was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.
