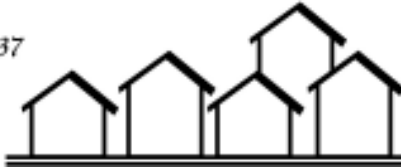

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, May 18, 2026 at 5:58 pm by Mayor James Meyer.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Rick Towers, Vern Sumner, Dan Glotzbach and Todd Reeves.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve the minutes of the May 4, 2026 meeting as presented was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Motion by Todd Reeves to pay bills as presented totaling \$51,096.49 was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve the agenda with addition of Myron Leinwetter was seconded by Trish Heim and carried.

Myron Leinwetter introduced Brett Waggoner, Grant Specialist with Governmental Assistance Services (GAS). Brett Waggoner reported on federal grant that would provide funding for Safe Streets for All project. Brett Waggoner also provided the City Council with information about LMI survey to determine the City's eligibility for CBDG grant applications. Following discussion motion by Todd Reeves to approve hiring GAS to conduct LMI survey at a cost of \$6,000.00 was seconded by Vernon Sumner and carried.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported that he had; contacted property owner at 117 E. Highway 24 regarding grass; provided escort for Stanley Oyler's funeral procession; scheduled a staff meeting and will have Don Hughes, KDOT law enforcement liaison speaking on STEP program; issued a notice to abate grass at 616 Green Street; spoken to owner of 150 Main Street about tall grass and would follow up has not been taken care of.

Chief Sipp discussed budgeting for full time officer, new police vehicle and raises.

Chief Sipp reported that he would provide traffic control for 5K run.

Clerk presented request for use of ball field, stadium and concession stand by Shawn Smith with Topeka Capitals Baseball. Council requested that Smith attend meeting to discuss use of facility.

Mayor reminded council that Saturday, May 23, 2026 would be ribbon cutting for newly refurbished grandstand.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:53pm.
