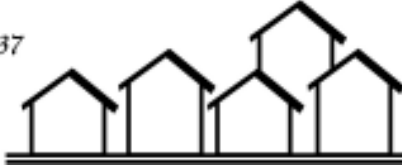

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, November 2, 2020 at 7:03 pm by Mayor Kenneth Wichman using online Zoom meeting.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$26,676.13 was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Motion by Trish Heim to approve agenda as written was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Mayor Wichman reported that the Shawnee County Commissioners were looking at the closed bridges over Cross Creek south of Rossville and would be getting bids for removal. Mayor also reported that the County Commissioners were still getting information to apply for grant to make repairs to the drainage ditch at north edge of Rossville.

Dan Glotzbach inquired about the cleaning of the concrete ditch on the east side of town. Utility Superintendent reported that the City cleans the concrete ditches once a year. Council had discussion regarding the property owners being responsible to maintain ditches and not allow grass and trash to be mowed into the ditches. No action was taken.

Dan Glotzbach reported that the railroad crossing sign along Anderson Street had been knocked down. Utility superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that this sign had been ran over twice and that personnel would get put back up.

Utility Superintendent Alan Zlatnik reported that they are working on getting the new radio read meters installed and have been digging several a day.

Trish Heim reported on email that was sent from WTC regarding possible plans to provide internet service to Rossville in 2021.

Clerk presented request for water bill adjustment due to leak from the Rossville American Legion Post #31. Motion by James Meyer to approve adjustment by half the overage was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Mayor presented request from employees to switch time off on Veteran's Day with the day after Thanksgiving. Motion by Trish Heim to allow employees to switch time off was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Council had discussion regarding City holiday dinner. Following discussion council scheduled dinner for December 9, 2020.

Jason Connell joined meeting at 7:27pm

Application for demolition permit from Haag Oil at 222 E. Highway 24 Trafficway was presented. Motion by Trish Heim to approve was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried.

Application for demolition permit for shed at 625 Main was presented. Motion by James Meyer to approve was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried.

Police Chief Jason Connell reported on police chase and arrest that had occurred today.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to adjourn was seconded by Toby McCullough and carried. Meeting adjourned at 7:38pm.
