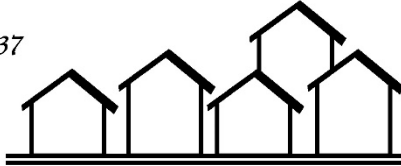

September 15, 2025

The Rossville City Council meeting was called to order on Monday, September 15, 2025 at 5:58pm by Council President Trish Heim.

Council members present were Trish Heim, Todd Reeves, Dan Glotzbach, Rick Towers and Vern Sumner.

Also present were Chance Stum and Thomas Sipp.

Motion by Rick Towers to approve the minutes of the September 2, 2025 meeting as written was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried.

Motion by Dan Glotzbach to pay bills as presented totaling \$35,670.98 was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried.

Motion by Todd Reeves to adopt agenda as presented was seconded by Rick Towers and carried.

Utility Superintendent Chance Stum reported that the SCADA system at the water pump house is 100% operational and is a more accurate system that has allowed them to increase in the water level in the tank by four foot providing the City with an additional 1-1 ½ days of storage and 2psi of pressure. Superintendent Stum also reported that the ball park grass seeding was completed, that two generators were purchased from Federal Surplus for sewer lift stations and that seven loads of gravel have been purchased for alleys.

Police Chief Thomas Sipp reported; that he had contacted resident at Adrian and Pine regarding overgrown flowers and that resident trimmed to prevent traffic hazard; that he and Captain Hammer along with Silver Lake Chief and Captain worked that football game and all went well; that the weeds need trimmed again at Short Stop property; that license plate readers at the police station have been activated and are now working; that abandoned vehicle at 602 Navarre has been resolved; that he came in on Saturday and provided traffic control for American Legion motorcycle ride and that he had contacted occupant at 423 Main regarding plans for building.

Council also discussed USD #321 being a member of the real time crime center and discussed speeding in construction zone and reviewed August incident report.

Ordinance AMENDING SECTION 4-202 OF THE CITY CODE DEALING WITH BUILDING PERMITS IN THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE KANSAS was presented. Following review of ordinance and list of projects requiring a permit motion by Rick Towers to approve ordinance was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 865.

Ordinance DEFINING BUILDER OR BUILDING CONTRACTOR AND DEALING WITH BUILDER'S OR BUILDING CONTRACTOR'S BOND; INSURANCE IN THE ROSSVILLE CITY CODE was presented. Following review motion by Todd Reeves to approve ordinance was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 866.

Ordinance AMENDING SECTION 4-205 OF THE CITY CODE DEALING WITH BUILDING INSPECTION FEES IN THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE KANSAS was presented. Following review motion by Rick Towers to approve ordinance was seconded by Dan Glotzbach and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 867.

Ordinance ESTABLISHING STOP SIGNS IN THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS was presented. Following review and discussion no action was taken.

Ordinance REPEALING SECTION 14-207 OF THE CITY CODE OF ROSSVILLE was presented. Following review motion by Todd Reeves to approve ordinance was seconded by Rick Towers and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 868.

Ordinance REGULATING PUBLIC OFFENSES WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "UNIFORM PUBLIC OFFENSE CODE FOR KANSAS CITIES," 41st EDITION 2025, AND REPEALING ORDINANCE # 862 was presented. Following review motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve ordinance was seconded by Todd Reeves and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 869.

Ordinance REGULATING TRAFFIC WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS; INCORPORATING BY REFERENCE THE "STANDARD TRAFFIC ORDINANCE FOR KANSAS CITIES," 52nd EDITION 2025, WITH CERTAIN OMISSIONS, CHANGES AND ADDITIONS; PRESCRIBING ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS; PROVIDING CERTAIN PENALTIES AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 861 was presented. Following review motion by Dan Glotzbach to approve ordinance was seconded by Rick Towers and carried. Ordinance was assigned number 870.

Clerk requested permission to request assistance from Jason Hoskinson of BG Consultants in applying for grant to make repairs to sewer lagoon splitter box and riprap. Council approved proceeding with request for assistance and grant application.

Council discussed progress on grandstand repairs. No action was taken.

Motion by Todd Reeves to adjourn was seconded by Vern Sumner and carried. Meeting adjourned at 6:49pm.
