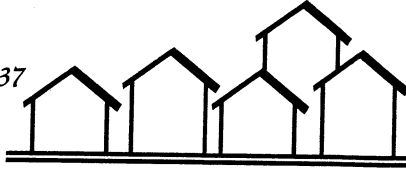

ORDINANCE 749

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 15-109 AND SECTION 15-110 OF THE CITY CODE OF ROSSVILLE AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NUMBER 696 AND 413 DEALING WITH SEWER RATES AND CHARGES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE CITY OF ROSSVILLE, KANSAS:

SECTION 1. Existing section 15-109 is hereby amended to read as follows:

RATES AND CHARGES. The schedule of rates and charges established and levied upon and under this article against the users of the sewer system of said City shall be as follows: For all commercial users a monthly service charge based on the monthly consumption of City water. A minimum charge of \$18.00 for water usage up to 2,000 gallons plus an additional charge of \$2.00 for each 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof additional usage. For all residential users a monthly service charge based on the monthly consumption of City water. A minimum charge of \$18.00 for water usage up to 2,000 gallons plus an additional charge of \$2.00 for each 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof additional usage up to 18,000 gallons.


SECTION 2. Existing section 15-110 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SAME: CERTAIN USERS. With respect to the rates and charges established in section 15-109 of this article, in the case of Multiple Dwelling users and in the case where more than one user in any class is connected to a single water meter, the charge for each such user shall be \$18.00 per user up to 2,000 gallons per user. Usage to be determined by dividing the total monthly water consumption for each user. Usage of over 2,000 gallons per user will be additional charge of \$2.00 for each 1,000 gallons or fraction thereof.

SECTION 3. City Ordinance Number 696 and 413 is hereby repealed.

THIS ORDINANCE SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER ITS ADOPTION AND PUBLICATION AS PROVIDED BY LAW.
